

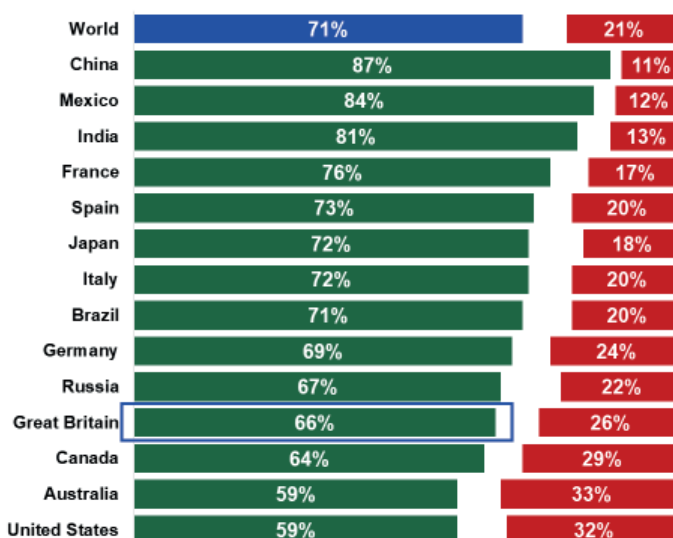
Two thirds of Britons believe Climate Change as serious as Coronavirus and majority want Climate prioritised in economic recovery

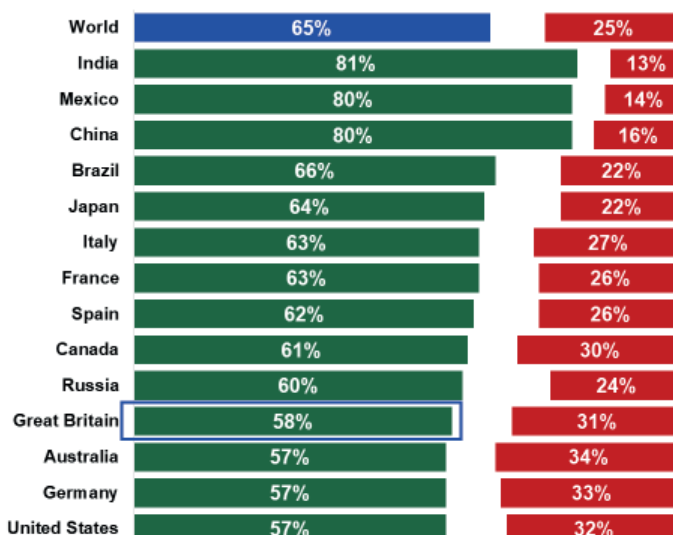

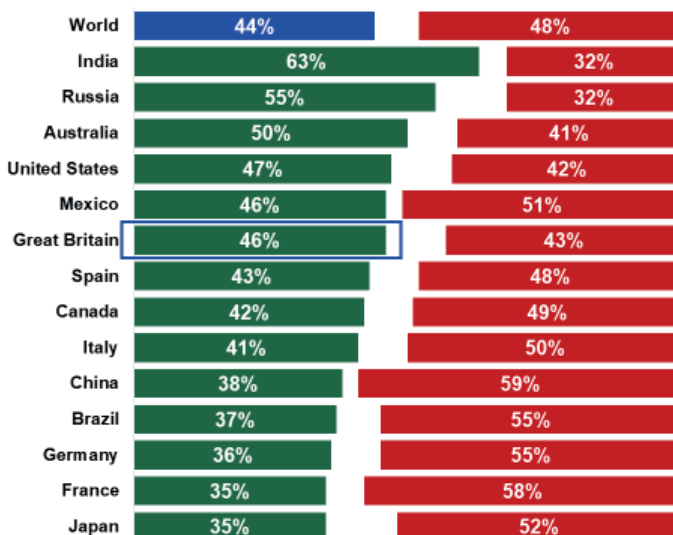
